**Under this agreement for 2017
Proston P-10 State School will receive**

\$73,215*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in Year 3 and 5 achieving NMS in reading to 95% in 2017.
- Improve teacher capacity in the implementation of literacy blocks encompassing Cars and Stars, Words Their Way and Decoding.
- Continue the operation of a Proston State School Kindy program in association with BSDE to aid in Early age development and transitions.
- Create a supportive and safe learning environment for SEP students in prep whilst building on all students' ability to successfully transition to year 1 and beyond.
- Improve the percentage of students attaining QCE through offering TAFE courses and other senior schooling pathway programs.
- Improve STEM education through the primary school years.
- Increase student educational outcomes through the creation of a comprehensive school wide curriculum plan.
- Enhance engagement between Proston SS and the broader community it services.

Our initiatives include

- Fostering early childhood education and transitioning to early years through our eKindy program.
- Continuing support and implementation of Cars and Stars and Words Their Way programs as well as investigation for, and then implementation of, an explicit decoding program.
- Supporting our Prep classroom through additional aide support and resourcing to assist in the transitioning of high level special needs students.
- More effective transitioning of Year 10's into senior schooling through engagement with TAFE and other pathways.
- Facilitating specialised STEM experiences for primary students.
- Ongoing support for the Levelled Literacy Intervention program for P – 3 students.
- Updating our whole school curriculum plan and literacy education plan.
- Investing in specialised well-being, engagement and extracurricular programs for secondary students.

• Funding for a facilitator and resources to support the Proston State School eKindy Pod.	\$25,000
• Creating a safe and supportive environment for Prep and SEP students through additional resource provisioning including additional teacher aide support.	\$11,000
• Resources and facilitation of Cert. II in Rural operations through TAFE South West and supporting transitioning of Year 10 students into senior secondary.	\$ 8,000
• STEM resourcing and facilitation of Primary STEM lessons.	\$ 7,000
• Purchasing of teacher release time for Curriculum and Literacy planning.	\$12,000
• Professional development for spelling and reading programs.	\$ 3,000
• Ongoing support of the Levelled Literacy Intervention program.	\$ 3,000
• Wellbeing, engagement and extra-curricular programs for secondary students.	\$ 4,215
